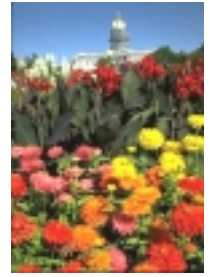

**Submission of Papers:** Full papers should be submitted electronically. The preferred submission format is PDF (\*.pdf). Postscript (\*.ps) and WORD (\*.rtf or \*.doc) submissions are acceptable but discouraged because postscript file sizes are usually very large and WORD files have printer dependent layouts. Submitted papers should not exceed 6 pages. Acceptance rate for this conference is typically 75%. The final version of the accepted papers must follow the IEEE Transactions layout. 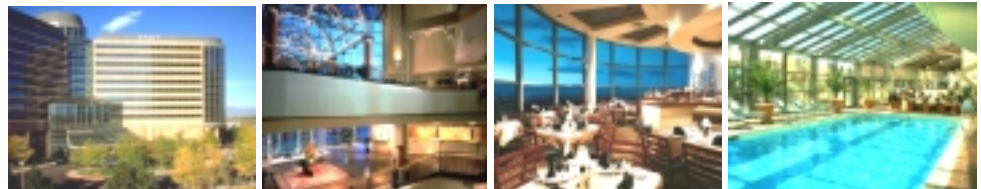
